Mr. OWEN, from the Committee of Ways and Means, reported the following bill :

A BILL

To amend an act entitled "An Act to establish branches of the mint of the United States," passed the third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That*
3 the officers of the branch mint at New Orleans shall be one su-
4 perintendent, one treasurer, one assayer, one melter and refiner,
5 and one coiner; and that the officers of the branch mints at
6 Charlotte and Dahlonega, severally, shall be one superintendent,
7 who shall also perform the duties of treasurer; one assayer, who
8 shall also perform the duties of melter and refiner; and one
9 coiner; and the annual salaries of the said officers shall be as
10 follows: for the branch at New Orleans, to the superintendent,
11 two thousand five hundred dollars; to the treasurer, the assayer,
12 the melter and refiner, and the coiner, each, two thousand dollars;
13 for the branches at Charlotte and at Dahlonega, to the superin-
14 tendent, two thousand dollars; and to the assayer and the coiner,
15 each, fifteen hundred dollars.

1 SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That so much of the act*

2 entitled "An act to establish branches of the mint of the United
3 States," approved this third day of March, one thousand eight
4 hundred and thirty-five, as is inconsistent with the provisions of
5 this act, be, and the same is hereby, repealed.
